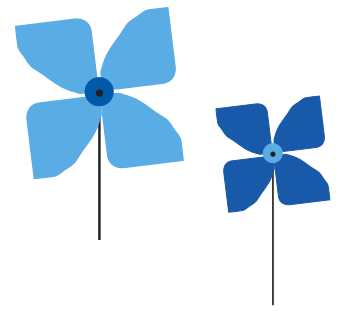

April is Child Abuse Prevention Month. Here are some ways your business can help create awareness:

-  Display the Blue Kids table top sign in your lobby and meeting areas.
-  Have your employees wear the bracelet "Protecting Children of Lake County" and encourage them to wear blue during the month of April.
-  Wear a blue lapel pin creating awareness on the cause during the month of April.
-  Place the "Spread Awareness ~ Stop Child Abuse" sticker on the front doors of your establishment.
-  Put blue pinwheels in the lawn area of your business (pinwheels are a National sign of hope for kids).
-  Pass out blue lollipops during the month of April.
-  Wednesday, April 14, 2021 is "Dress in Blue Day". Encourage your staff to wear blue to work that day to show support for preventing child abuse and neglect.
-  Post information on your departments social media sites creating awareness about Child Abuse Prevention Month.
-  Have materials for staff in break areas about abuse and how to keep their kids safe.
-  Network with a local charity to raise awareness and collect funds to support the cause.
-  Display literature in common areas on Stress Management and Importance of Family Bonds.
